Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy has applies solely to the online information and collection practices of the Harlowsave Credit Union website located at <http://www.harlowsave.coop>.

Users of this website may be concerned about the information they provide to us and how we treat that information. This privacy policy has been developed to address those concerns. Your use of this website indicates that you have read and accept our privacy practices as outlined in this Privacy Policy.

Collected Information

When you visit the Harlowsave Credit Union website, you may provide us with two types of information: (1) personal information that you knowingly choose to disclose, which is collected on an individual basis and (2) general user information that does not contain personally identifiable information, which is collected on an aggregate basis as you browse the website. In some cases, if you choose not to provide us with the requested information, you may not be able to access all of our website's contents and services. □□Personally identifiable you choose to provide:

We may ask for certain personal information from you for the purpose of providing to you content and/or services that you request. You may provide us with details about yourself so that we can send you information about our products and services, and subscribe to our email newsletter. You may be asked to disclose personal information to us so that we can provide assistance and information to you. For example, we may collect personal information from you (such as an e-mail address, system information and problem descriptions) in order to provide online technical support and troubleshooting. □□Non-personally identifiable information we collect:

Cookies/web server logs: as with other similar websites, our website uses standard technology called 'cookies' and web server logs to collect information about how our webs site is used.

Cookies are a feature of web browser software that allows web servers to recognise the computer used to access a website. Cookies are small pieces of data that are stored by a user's web browser on the user's hard drive. Information gathered through cookies and web server logs may include the date and time of visits, the pages viewed, time spent at our website and the websites visited just before and just after our website. This information is collected on an aggregate basis. None of this information is associated with you as an individual. You can, of course, disable cookies on your computer by indicating this in the preference or options menus in your browser. Most browsers allow you to reject all cookies, whilst some browsers allow you to reject just third party cookies. For example, in Internet Explorer you can refuse all cookies by clicking "Tools", "Internet Options", "Privacy", and selecting "Block all cookies" using the sliding selector. Blocking all cookies will, however, have a negative impact upon the usability of many websites, including this one.

We may provide access to your personally identifiable information when legally required to do so, to cooperate with police investigations or other legal proceedings, to limit our liability to protect our rights, or to protect the rights and safety of the public. In those instances, the information is provided only for that limited purpose.
